Being led away with the error of the wicked translated as...

The deceit of the lawless

The lawless...those who are contemptuous of God's word

The lawless... those who rationalize themselves out of heeding God's word

According to Promise Look for a New Heavens

Deut. 32:1-7

(1) **Give ear, O ye heavens**, and I will speak; and **hear, O earth**, the words of my mouth

.

(7) **Remember the days of old**, consider the years of many generations: **ask thy father, and he will shew thee; thy elders, and they will tell thee.**

Jeremiah 6:16

Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and **ask for the old paths, where *is* the good way, and walk therein**, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk *therein*.

According to Promise Look for a New Heavens

Proverbs 22:28

landmark: Hebrew gebûl (H1379); properly a *cord* (as *twisted*), that is, (by implication) **a *boundary***; by extension **the *territory enclosed***:

Hosea 5:1-5, 10

(10) The princes of Judah were like them that remove the ***bound***
(gebul)

Deut. 27:17 & 19:14
